



Rank in class

shall be computed by totaling the weighted rank points of eligible courses representing the highest twenty-four credits taken and earned in grades 9-12.

Course weights are assigned to Texas Education Agency approved courses as follows:

- Advanced Placement 9
- Pre-AP 8
- Regular Education/ESOL 7

To obtain rank points, the semester grade in each course is multiplied by the course weight. For example, a student earns a grade of 92 in an English I class for the fall semester. Since English is a regular education course, the student earns 644 points ($92 \times 7 = 644$) for the semester class.

Rank in class will be calculated at the end of each semester beginning with the first semester of the junior year.
